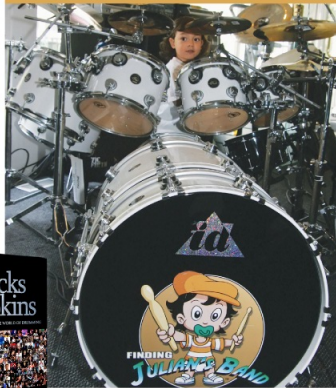


# Julian Pavone

"The World's Youngest Drummer!" ©



Playing the drums while sitting atop his father's lap since the age of three months, this rhythmic child began keeping a steady beat on his mother's womb. Featured at three years old on his 11-piece custom drum set, Julian, now only five years old, plays a 22-piece custom drum set with 17 cymbals and a double bass. He plays rock, funk, fusion, and jazz and has full artist endorsements with three major companies. Many consider Julian to be the "Tiger Woods of the music industry". He was offered a contract from The United Drum Line at age 16 months and at 20 months recorded a CD, *Go Baby!*, with legendary bassist Rayje Armstrong.



He has appeared on numerous TV shows, including *The Oprah Winfrey Show*, *Good Morning America*, *The Martha Stewart Show*, *Nascar Station*, *NBC*, *WGN*, *FOX News*, *DaySix*, and *Good Company*. He has also starred in a television show pilot, *Finding Julian's Band*, and a Korean documentary. He has performed live on numerous radio stations around the world, for the Cleveland Cavaliers, Cleveland Indians, Chicago Cubs, Detroit Tigers, Detroit Pistons, and even the House of Blues. He has inspired the formation of Harmonie Network, a national entertainment company, launched his own clothing line, invented "Abracadabra" Stan Cover-up, was featured in Ripley's Believe It or Not!, was honored at the Cleveland Hard Rock Cafe with the 2007 Rock and Roll Lifetime Achievement Award, won The Meury Show's 2009 Most Talented Kid Contest, and received worldwide media coverage with over 2,000 newspaper and magazine articles written about him.

And all of this was accomplished before his 6th birthday!
